Family Support

Last week I visited **East Cowes Community Food Pantry** at the Community Spirited Café on Vectis Road to find out what support they could offer Queensgate families.

I was given a very warm welcome from Jane and the other staff / volunteers. They explained the process of the pantry which is very easy to access, with no referral necessary. Families are able to visit once a week and pay £5 in exchange for around £15 worth of food of your own choosing. They had a great selection of meats, dairy products, cereals, eggs and tinned food.

The food pantry runs on the following days and are open as usual throughout the school holidays.

Wednesday and Thursday from 10:30 until 12:30.

Message from the Mental Health Support Team

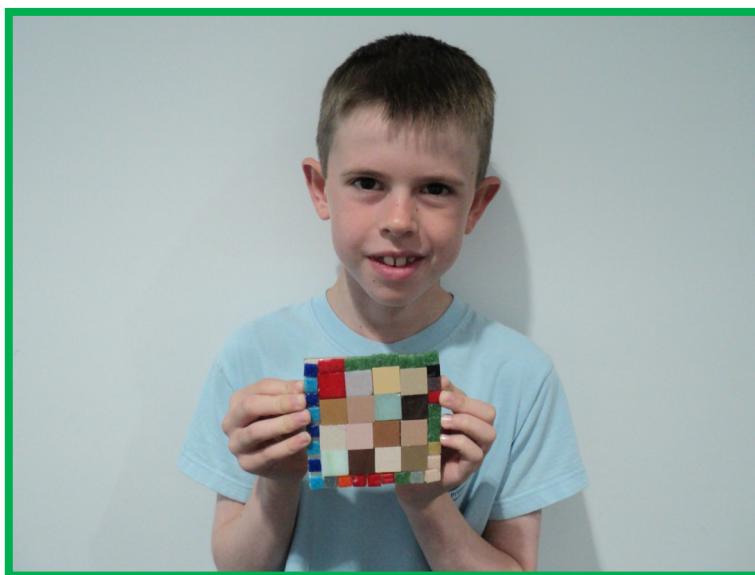

Love reading?

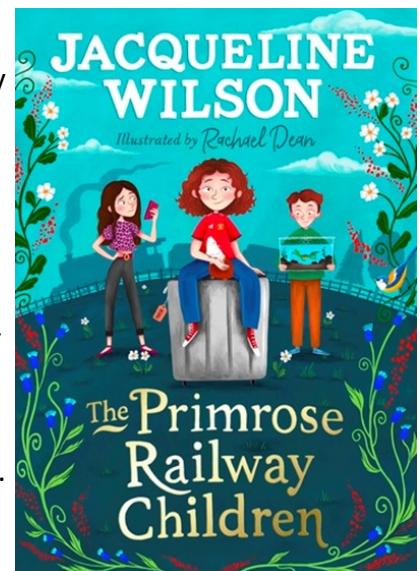
Then try this....

The last two weeks of term is very busy. Here is what is coming up...

On **Friday 15th July** we will be sending home end of year reports. Please could you return the Parents and comments slip and the questionnaire? We are very keen to hear your feedback.

Remember the Queensgate Summer Fair is on **Saturday 16th July** from 11am until 3pm. There will be many stalls for you to enjoy and don't forget the dog show and bake off!

On **Monday 18th July** Year 1 will be visiting Puckpool Park as part of their work about beaches and for an end of term celebration.

Also our cricket team will be taking part in Incrediball on **Monday 18th July** at Newclose cricket ground.

We have Key Stage 2 sports day on **Tuesday 19th July** from 9:15am to 12:00pm. All children need to be in a Queensgate PE kit with a logoed T-shirt. Hair needs to be tied back and the children should not wear any jewellery. Please send the children with a named water bottle. Please also make sure they are wearing suntan lotion and have a hat with them.

It is exactly the same rules for the Key Stage 1 sports day which is on **Wednesday 20th July** from 9:15am – 11:30am. Parents need to stay one side of the track and the children will need to stay on the other side of the track. Refreshments will be sold by the PTFA.

Also on **Wednesday 20th July** at 5:00pm there is the show called Thursday's Child. It costs £2 and all proceeds go to UNICEF.

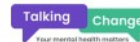

New food voucher scheme

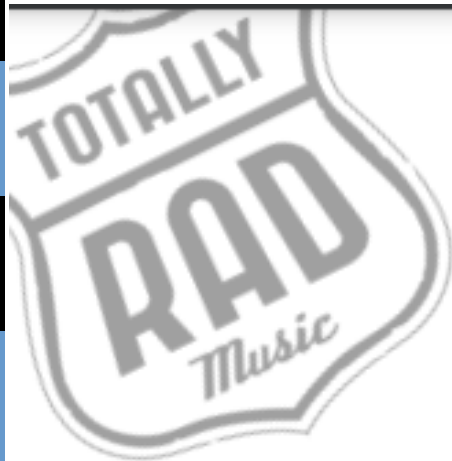

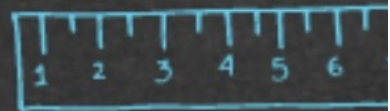
