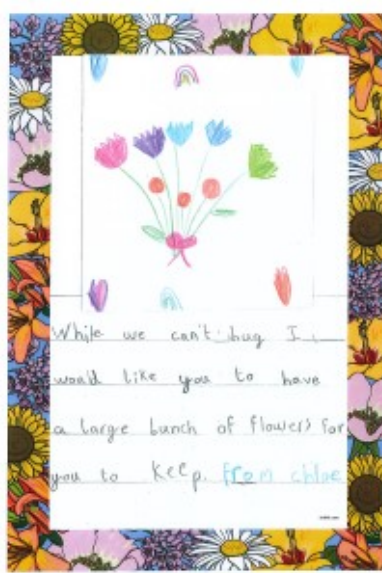
If you have any worries, concerns or positive comments about home learning please do let myself, Mr Chubb or your child's class teacher know and we will do all that we can to support you.

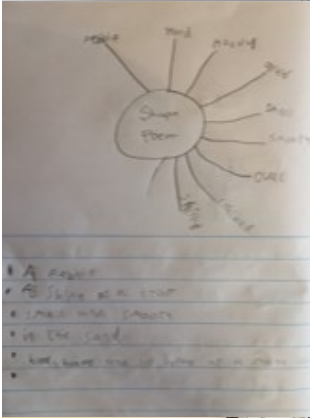

No shelter cats and dogs.

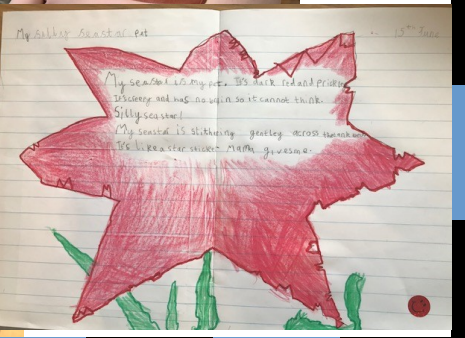
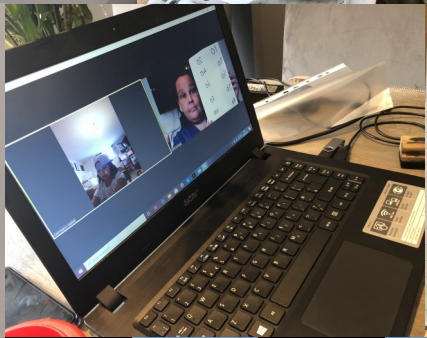
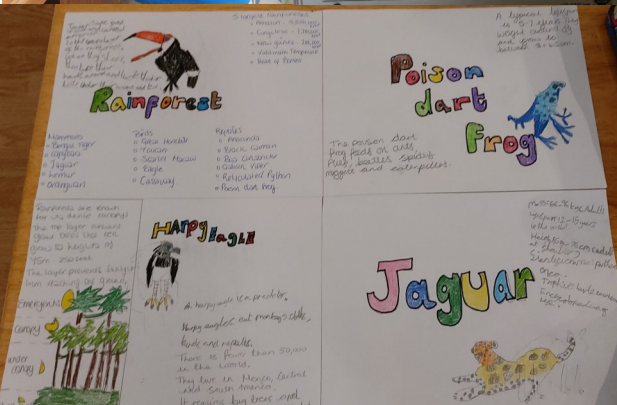
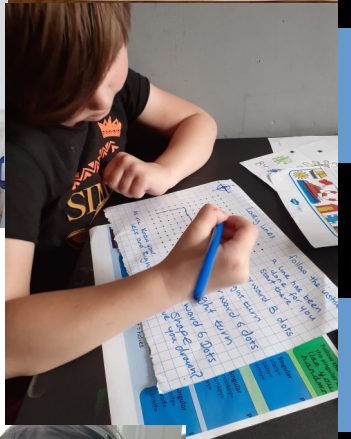
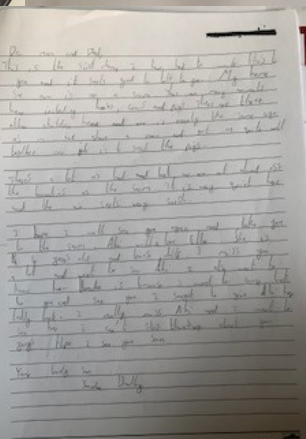
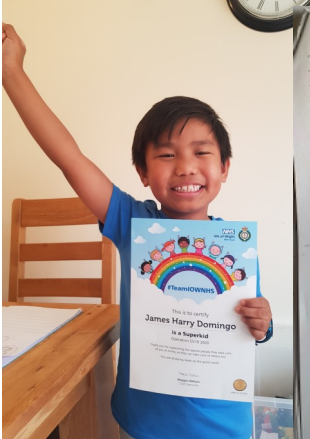
