		Hook: Children will watch the film Hercules to give an insight to Ancient Greek culture.
		Rationale: Children will start by reading "Here Comes Hercules" by Stella Tarakson and explore Ancient Greek mythology. They will design and make Greek Puppets for a puppet show of their myth.
Outcome: The children will create their own Greek myths and publish them as a book. The children will be able to talk about Ancient Greece and will be successful in making their own characters into puppets.		
Topic: Ancient Greece	Focus Area: History Children will learn about the greatest achievements of Ancient Greek civilization. We will cover the following enquiry questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What can excavations tell us about early Greece? • What was life like in Ancient Greece? • What was trade like in Ancient Greece? • What was life like in Athens and Sparta? <p>They will also discover elements of Ancient Greece through cookery, art and design and English.</p>	Focus Area: Art Pupils will be researching Ancient Greek puppetry and associated stories. They will design their own characters in relation to their own Greek myth created in English. They will then use their drawing, painting and sculpture skills to create Ancient Greek inspired puppets.
